Dear Parents

Feedback from Parents

It has been good to meet with many parents on Monday mornings this term to discuss school life and to hear your feedback. Mr Hagger and I have the final meeting with senior parents in the week after half term. I hope you have found these meetings useful.

Thank you also to all those families who completed the recent online parental survey. Every three years or so we send out a questionnaire to help us see what our parents think about the education we are offering. This then feeds into our strategic development plan for the school. Your views are very important to us. We will now analyse the questionnaire responses and Mr Hagger and I will be writing to parents to share the feedback with you.

11+ Exams for Senior Entry

The admission process finishes before half-time and offers and scholarships are sent out in the holidays. Our own Year 6 pupils were excellent ambassadors for Normanhurst on the examination day. They welcomed the prospective pupils warmly, as well as approaching the exam papers with maturity, determination and focus. I was very proud of them.

Year 11 Easter Academy

Year 11 should now be committed to working towards their GCSE exams in May. They have received their mock examination results and full reports. We are providing as many opportunities as we can for our pupils to make progress and succeed, but as I am sure you appreciate, there is no substitute for hard work and persistence.

As always we will be offering revision days as part of our annual Easter academy programme, as well as extra 'masterclass' sessions for English and Maths. I urge all parents to make every effort to ensure that their children attend the revision classes on offer. Teachers voluntarily give up their time, even at weekends and in school holidays to provide opportunities to support the students in revision and it is essential that as many pupils as possible attend.
