Headmistress's Letter

Dear Parents

GCSE Examinations

The staff and I are proud of how our Year 11 have approached their final weeks before the GCSE exams start. We have seen determination, commitment and sheer hard work from so many of the year group. This year almost all subjects have the new GCSE exams, with grades from 9-1, with 9 being the highest grade.

The new exams are harder, with more content, no coursework and a greater number of written final papers. There is a considerable amount our pupils have been doing in order to prepare well so that they can achieve their best.

I hope our pupils feel well-prepared and positive as their exams start. I wish them well; the staff are all behind them and I look forward to sharing the good news of their results in August.

Year 10 Apprentice Prefects

As Year 11 begin their study leave, those members of Year 10 who have applied to be prefects will have interviews and become apprentice prefects, in advance of the selection and announcement of the new Prefect Team. The prefect team comprises 12 Senior Prefects including the Head Boy and Head Girl, House Captains and Senior Prefects. The final team will be announced as usual on Speech Day.

ISA Regional Athletics Friday 11 May

The ISA regional athletics competition took place on Friday 11 May. The PE department took about 50 pupils to represent the school in Bedford. It was an exciting event, with hundreds of competitors. There are over nearly 100 ISA schools in our region, in fact we are the largest region nationally, so this gives pupils the opportunity to compete in a large venue with pupils from many other independent schools.

I am delighted that we had some regional gold medals again this year, which means that those individual competitors or teams will represent the region in the prestigious national ISA Athletics Competition in Birmingham on Tuesday 19 June at the Alexander Stadium. Over the years we have had many pupils selected for Nationals, which is an excellent achievement. Once again this year I will be presenting medals at the event, so I am looking forward to the chance of presenting a medal to one of our own pupils.

Sports Day Thursday 24 May

Sports Day takes place at the Lee Valley Athletics track for all classes up to Year 10. As usual the senior sports day will be in the morning from 9.30am and the juniors will be in the afternoon from 1.00pm. All parents, families and friends are invited to join us for the event. The pupils will compete in their Houses and the junior and senior sports shields will be presented.

Pupils come to school in their sports kit on the day, including track suit, and should bring sun block with them; juniors should wear their school caps. Parents of early years and junior aged pupils may take their children home directly from the track at the end of the afternoon; alternatively, pupils return to school by coach and can be collected from school or from After School Club.

Years 7-10 End of Year Examinations

Senior school summer exams are in the week after half-term. During this week normal lessons are suspended and pupils have their exams instead. PE takes place as usual. These assessments form an important part of our monitoring of pupil progress over the course of the year. Parents and pupils will have received a copy of the exam timetable. Please encourage your sons and daughters to revise thoroughly for these assessments, which review the year's learning. Pupils are being advised on revision techniques in form time and with their subject teachers, and teachers will be directing pupils towards what they should revise.

Junior End of Year Examinations

Junior pupils also have their assessments split over two weeks. In the week beginning Monday 11 June, pupils in Years 1-6 have their assessments in English, Maths and Science and they also have the annual INCAS progress assessment. All the assessments are to help us evaluate the progress each individual child has made over the course of the year. Miss Barnard is sending parents more detailed information about the assessments, and the class assessment timetable.

Clubs from September

We are finalising the Extra-curricular clubs list for September at the moment and parents will receive a copy of the schedule at half-term. There is a wide range of activities for pupils to select in the Autumn term and I hope they enjoy the choices on offer.
