## Re: Headmistress's Letter

I cannot believe February half term is approaching so quickly. This has been yet another busy Spring Term full of rich and diverse learning experiences. I wanted to begin by congratulating the Normanhurst pupils for their approach to learning. It has been a pleasure to observe pupils really engaging in lessons, asking questions and responding with enthusiasm.

#### 11+ Exams

It has been wonderful to meet so many excellent 11+ candidates this year who have applied to join Normanhurst in September. Following their examinations, I am meeting each of them individually for an interview and having the opportunity to talk to them about our school. The offers for places will be sent out on Friday 10 February and this includes the scholarship offers. Some of our internal Year 6 pupils have also applied for scholarships and I shall be interviewing them over the coming days.

## **Sparx**

Senior pupils from Years 7-10 have been using Hegarty Maths to support their home learning. These year groups will be introduced to the Sparx learning platform as we begin to phase out the use of Hegarty Maths. Sparx is a newly developed and improved version of Hegarty Maths, created by the same company. It develops pupils' understanding of maths through personalised retrieval practice. It will encourage mastery, and develop pupils' understanding of mathematical concepts. Mrs Mouslmani will be introducing Sparx to Years 7-10 pupils in lessons throughout this month.

One of the features of the platform is that parents are notified by email of the progress of their child's homework. For parents to have access to this feature, parents will need to give permission for their email address to be shared with Sparx, for this purpose only. Further details will sent to parents by Mrs Mouslmani very soon.

## **Parents' Evenings**

It has been excellent to see such good attendance at the Parents' Evenings this term and pleasing to hear from parents that these meetings are purposeful and very much valued. The Year 7 Parents' Evening will take place on Tuesday 7 February in the Hall. Please ensure you arrive in time for your first appointment as there is no scope to change appointment times on the evening. In the seniors it is very important that your children attend with you and are part of the feedback in the meetings. Teachers will discuss your child's learning and progress. They will want to celebrate what is going well, and will want to identify areas for your children to focus on as they move forward in their learning this year.

Thank you to all the parents who have been able to attend the Coffee Mornings or emailed feedback, this feedback is invaluable. I know Mr Hagger, Mrs Osborn and I have very much enjoyed meeting parents during this cycle and appreciate hearing what you have to say. ## **Year 11 GCSE Mocks and Summer Examinations**

Year 11 pupils will complete their second set of Mock examinations from Tuesday 2 March to Monday 13 March. They will be given a timetable and this will also be uploaded to the portal. They have plenty of time for revision to prepare, and support will be provided during Quality Improvement Time and after school Boosters. These exams

will take place in lesson time in the United Reformed Church and other rooms in school. In between exams, pupils will have lessons and be supported to revise.

It is extremely important that if your child is in school, they attend the relevant after school boosters for their subjects. These happen on a weekly basis. If your child has additional tuition, this should not be arranged when your children is expected to attend the after school boosters.

During the Easter holidays we will also be hosting our Easter Academy from Monday 3 April to Friday 14 April as the pupils move closer towards their examinations. Pupils do not have to be in uniform during these days. They must sign in and out as they enter and leave the building. I hope Year 11 will use these opportunities to enhance their revision. Details of this timetable will be sent to parents shortly.
