## **Staff Update**

## Senior Assessments and Examinations for Years 7 to 10

This is advance notice of assessments and examinations happening for Years 7 to 10. We plan to run the scheduled end-of-year assessments and examinations in April, May and June. Year 10 exams will take place from Monday 29 April to Friday 3 May. End-of-Year exams will take place for Years 7 to 9 from Monday 3 to Friday 7 June.

#### **Senior Entrance Examinations**

The main Entrance Examination for new pupils wishing to join the Seniors at Year 8 or 9 from September 2024 will be held on Wednesday 13 March.

There will also be an additional opportunity to take the 11+ Entrance Examination on this date for prospective pupils who were unable to attend in January.

## Year 11 GCSE Update

Year 11 pupils have completed their second set of Mock examinations and are now on the final stages before their GCSEs start at the beginning of May.

They have already received a copy of the summer exam timetable and this is also available on Show My Homework. All schools are required to keep reserve exam dates available in case this is needed for exams. We will be informing Year 11 parents separately about these dates.

Revision is underway in preparation for the summer exams, which take place at the United Reformed Church hall and in other places at school. In between exams, pupils will have sessions to help them with focused revision before exams.

During the Easter holidays from Thursday 28 March to Tuesday 9 April we will also be hosting our Easter Academy as the pupils move closer towards their examinations. Pupils do not have to be in uniform on these days. I hope Year 11 take this opportunity to support their revision by attending on site.

As we move closer towards the summer exams, we will be celebrating the Year 11's efforts and hard work by hosting a Celebration Breakfast followed by the annual Year 11 Normanhurst School Prom on Monday 1 July at The King's Oak at 6.30pm.
